- Sharpening and maintaining machine tools.
- Participating in the PM program on all equipment for continuous improvement of all machines.
- Keeping detailed and accurate maintenance reports and documentation.
- Cleaning, lubricating and performing other routine maintenance work on machineries.
- Adhering to workplace safety policies, regulations, GMP, WHMIS.

- Install, align, dismantle and move stationary industrial machinery and mechanical equipment, such as pumps, fans, tanks & conveyors using hand & power tools according to layout plans.
